Repair the potholes and road surfaces on Crookston Road near Lidl, Linthaugh Road where the calming turns are (it's very bad) the road is badly needing repaired.	74% of people said YES	£500
Improve pavement surface throughout Pollok Ward to improve accessibility for disabled people.	74% of people said YES	£116,100
Clean the rivers surrounding Pollok, the Brockburn, Lavern Water and the Cart and build a bird viewing station possibly behind the fire station: There is an abundance of wildlife that inhabit the river. Local school, families and children will be able to enjoy this.	72% of people said YES	£30,000
Repair the potholes on Leithland Road.	70% of people said YES	£500
Improve surfaces on pavements and roads and reduce curb heights to support wheelchair users, people with mobility issues and prams to move around more easily between Hapland Road and the length of Braidcraft Road up to Silverburn.	71% of people said YES	£7,500
Improve drainage systems at the traffic lights on Braidcraft Road/ Lavernside	71% of people said YES	£500
Tackle persistent flooding and improve drainage systems from Braidcraft Roundabout driving towards Cardonald College.	71% of people said YES	£500
Improve lighting in Househill Park to make it safer for young people, women and dog walkers after dark and during winter.	71% of people said YES	This is being reviewed city-wide
The total removal of the cycle lanes on Brockburn Road, Lintaugh Road and Braidcraft Road, or to move them onto the local side street. It makes no sense as cyclists have to join onto the dual carriageway of Crookston Road which in itself is dangerous. They don't get used enough by cyclists to be justified and emergency services are still stuck in traffic on Brockburn Road.	68% of people said YES	Cycle lanes achieve objectives for net zero and active travel strategies. This feeds into Pollok Roundabout plans.
Introduce trees and raingardens to reduce flooding across Greater Pollok.	68% of people said YES	Raingardens should be focused in school playgrounds.
Tackle persistent flooding at the junction of Peat Road and Priesthill Road to make the pavements more accessible.	68% of people said YES	£500
Improve drainage and adress flooding in Crookston Road.	67% of people said YES	£500
Improve the grounds surrounding the Nithsill War Memorial to make it an enjoyable space in the community for everyone to access: Make this space accessible to all, in particular people with disabilities. Introduce railings to the open space at Barrhead Road opposite Tesco to stop pupils from St Pauls High running across the busy road.	66% of people said YES	Barriers for 100m cost approx £7 000. need investigated
Improve and fix the kids park in Cleeves so children have somewhere to go and enjoy! This park only has the odd slide and swing. we need equipment for younger ones under 5 and older one for over 5.	65% of people said YES	£55,000
Improve Househillwood play area by extending it and introducing play equipment adapted for children with complex needs. Make this a nice, accessible and secure space for children and young people. Better facilities, swings, sports courts.	65% of people said YES	£180,000
Improve surfaces on pavements and roads and reduce curb heights to support wheelchair users, people with mobility issues and prams to move around more easily in Househillwood area.	65% of people said YES	£25,800
Improve drainage systems at Nitshill shops on Maybole Street.	62% of people said YES	£500
The junction at Priesthill Road and Peat Road needs lined directions to assist when turning onto Peat Road, this has caused many accidents.	61% of people said YES	Full investigation needed by various departments
